Thane District Selections 2018 – Under 9 and 17 age category**

Thane District Chess Association will be organizing District Selection for Under 9 and 17 age categories on 12<sup>th</sup> August 2018. Boys & Girls will play separately.

If there are less than 6 participants in girls category, they will be clubbed with boys category. However, separate prizes will be given to women in the event of clubbing.

This event will be District Selection for State Level Chess Tournaments to be held in 2018-19.

Only players from Thane District can participate in this selection. (Thane, Navi Mumbai, Mira Road, Kalyan region)

**Venue: Shreerang Vidyalaya, Shreerang Society, Near Castle Mill, Thane, Maharashtra 400601**

**Submission of the entries to be done online at [www.thanechess.com](http://www.thanechess.com)**

Prior Registration compulsory on TDCA Website. There will be no Spot registration.

**Details of the tournament:**

- Date: 12<sup>th</sup> August 2018 (Sunday). **Reporting is 8.00 am**
- Entry Fee: Rs.500/- per player.
- Time control: 20 min plus 3 sec increment per move
- Participation certificates for all.

**PRIZES**

1. Total 5 Trophies in Under 9 and 17. (Boys & Girls Separate)
2. Top 2 winners from both categories will be given free entry for state level

## Selected Players for State:

Those who are selected in this event have to give confirmation form to Chief Arbiter before leaving the tournament venue. Due to some circumstances, if a selected player is unable to participate in State Tournament, that player should inform the same at least 10 days before the State Tournament otherwise he/she has to pay penalty **or Rs.2,000/- to TDCA.**

If cancellation occurs at the last minute because of some unavoidable conditions i.e., ill health of player, Death of near ones, then various documentary evidence will be required like medical certificate and letter from school( as per the reason given) etc to avoid penalty.

## Reimbursement Claim:

The reimbursement is only for those participants who got selected in Thane District Selection tournament for the current year. After completion of tournament he/she has to submit the entry fee receipt of state tournament played within one month. TDCA will issue cheque or deposit the money in the your account.

## **Rules and Regulations**

1. Tournament will be played on a 'SWISS LEAGUE' basis as per the FIDE Guidelines.
2. A player is eligible to play all the rounds, irrespective of win/loss/draw.
3. Entry Fee once paid shall not be refunded.
4. The decision of the Arbiters will be final and binding on all.
5. Organizer reserves the right to accept or reject any entry.
6. General discipline should be maintained at tournament venue
7. It is compulsory for players to be present for the opening and closing ceremony of tournament.
8. Players are requested to switch off their cell phones during the game. If cell phone rings, the game will be considered as a loss
9. Spectators (Including players who have finished their games, parents, managers and coaches) should stay away from playing area during the rounds especially age category.
10. Use of improper language with the officials or organizers will lead to expulsion of player from the tournament.
11. Interpretation: For interpretation of the rule(s) and deciding any point not covered by the above rules of the tournament, the decision of the tournament committee, comprising organizer, chief Arbiter and one of the TDCA officials shall be final and binding on all. The Tournament committee has every right to make any addition or amendment to these rules, without notice. However, such changes will be displayed in the tournament venue.
